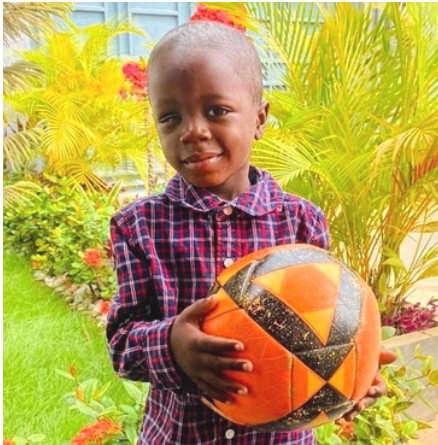

You are Helping Children with Eye Tumors

Anakpa is one of five of those children.

Anakpa had a tumor in his eye. We cannot show you a before photo because it is too graphic. **Anakpa could not go to school and rarely left his house because of his tumor. These kids are often social outcasts.**



Our team could not treat Anakpa but we knew if he was left untreated, he could die. Meheza, our Togo Director, took him to a specialist in the neighboring country of Ghana.

Because of donations like yours, we were able to pay for his surgery, chemo treatment, and a new prosthetic eye.

This has vastly improved Anakpa's quality of life. He can walk around in public happily. He can go to school. He can play with friends.

A few weeks ago, Anakpa and his parents were traveling back to Ghana for follow up treatments. They stopped at Meheza's house to say thank you. He calls Meheza "mama."

Anakpa is not the first child to come to us with an eye tumor. **We have been able to send five children to the hospital in Ghana to get treatment.** There are three children currently receiving treatment.

Let's Eliminate Long-Term Blindness in Togo!

Unfortunately, blindness from cataracts will always exist in Togo, but what does not need to exist is long-term blindness. We have found many who have been blind for well over a decade, and we want this to end. Last year, we performed 1,300 surgeries, but I would like to see beyond 2,000 surgeries performed each year. At this rate, we will begin to see the end of long-term blindness and turn our attention to those blinded for months, not decades. You are helping us make this a reality.
